The University announced earlier that campus operations should gradually resume starting from 1 February 2021. To coincide with the Government's recent announcement of resuming all public services <https://www.info.gov.hk/gia/general/202102/10/P2021021000599.htm>, the University will fully resume normal operations starting from next Thursday, 18 Feb 2021.
